FAMILY

Okaasan (oh-KAAH-san) - This is the word for a mother, usually someone else's. Children, or young people, often say "Kaasan". Another way to refer to one's own parents (I think) is "Haha". You can hear an example of how this is used in Escaflowne. Van refers to his mother as "Haha-wei". I'm not entirely sure what the "wei" suffix means, but I believe it's an older, more respectful form of the word. Also, you hear "Mama" used by various age groups.

Oniichan (oh-KNEE-chan) - This is the word for brother. Again, it's the basic word. You'll hear people, especially youngsters, refer to their brothers as "Niichan" alot, and guys will often use this to be familiar with each other. Sort of like saying Hey bro'! In my experience, girls rarely, if ever, use it in that manner. Another, more formal word is "Aniki" (I think). You also hear Van in Escaflowne refer to his brother Folken as "Ani-wei".

Otousan (oh-TOE-san) - This is the word for "father". "Tousan" is also another typical word for referring to a father by his children. "Chichi" is also a way to refer to your father. "Papa" is another one you'll hear alot. I think "Otoutou" is the way you refer to someone else's father.

Onehchan (oh-NEH-chan) - Way to refer to your own sister. This is the "Nechan" you were to. The only change is that it ends in "chan" in stead of "sama". The "sama" ending implies a higher respect level, which there are at least 4 distinct levels of. I'm sure there about a million, but they're beyond me. The word for someone else's sister is "Immoto".

Something else you'll sometimes hear, usually used by males to describe other, older males, is "Ji-san". It comes from "Ojisan" which means either "uncle" or "grandfather". It's sort of a way of saying old man, and can be used as a term of familiarity (sometimes older, college/high school age people will call their father this), or as an aggressive stance against someone older than you.

Another one is "Obaasan" which means 'grandmother'. You'll often hear people refer to old ladies in anime as "obasan" or "bachan" or something. Also makes for good comedy when a child calls a young woman this in an anime.

Sama is usually, used for someone of high power

EX: Kami-sama (God); Kings and Queen are "sama"... And so on.

Family: Gokazoku (someone else's family) kazoku (your family)

Father: Otousan (Someone else father) Chichi (Your father)

Mother: Okaasan (someone else Mother) Haha (Your mother)

Older Bro: Oniisan (Someone else Bro) Ani (Your brother)

Younger Bro: Otoutosan (Someone else Y. Bro) Otouto (Your bro)

Older sis: Oneesan (someone else O. Sis) Ane (Your sis)

Younger Sis: Imoutosan (someone else Y. Sis) Imouto (Your sis)

Grandmother: Obaasan (someone else Granny) Soba (Your Granny)

Grandfather: Ojiisan (someone else Grandpa) Sofu (your Grandpa)

After your families name (bro, sis... etc) you can put "San" Or "Chan"

So if you see Samurai movies they call their family like this.

Father- Chichi ue

Big brother- Ani ue

Big sister- Ane ue

THE BASIC JAPANESE GRAMMAR

In English: the subject word + the verb (Be) + a noun.

For instance, I am the walrus.

The subject word is "I", the verb (Be) is "am", a noun is "the walrus".

In Japanese: the subject word + a noun + the verb (Be) (usually the verb of Be is translated "-desu" in Japan)

For instance, Watashi ha Seiuchi desu. (Seiuchi means the walrus)

The subject word is "Watashi ha", a noun is "Seiuchi", the verb of Be is "desu".

Decline of the first person

I is "Watashi ha". The ending of word "ha" means the nominative case.

For instance, "I am a student" is "Watashi **ha** Gakusei desu". (Gakusei means student)

My is "Watashi no". The ending of word "no" means the possessive case.

For instance, "My cat" is "Watashi **no** Neko". (Neko means cat)

Me is "Watashi ni". The ending of word "ni" means the objective case.

For instance, "Give me" is "Watashi **ni** Kudasai".

This rule are adapted to other person.

You is "Anata ha" or "Anata ni". You are great! is "Anata ha Idai desu". (Idai means great).

Your is "Anata no". Your Manga is "Anata no Manga".

"He/She" is "Kare ha/Kanojo ha". He is the Superman is "Kare ha Superman desu".

"His/Her" is "Kare no/Kanojo no". His brother is "Kare no Kyoudai". (Kyoudai means brother)

"Him/Her" is "Kare ni/Kanojo ni" "I meet him" is "Watashi ha Kare ni Au". (Au means meet)

"and" is translated "to" in Japan.

You and I is "Anata to Watashi".

"I have Anime and Manga" is "Watashi ha Anime to Manga **wo** Motteiru". (Motteiru means have)

wo means an object.

"I have a cat" is "Watashi ha Neko wo Katteiru". (Usually "have" is translated

"Katteiru" when in animal case)
